

Akumal Art & Water Community Park

Conceived by Board Members of the U.S. non-profit Hekab Be Biblioteca and the Akumal Arts Festival, The Akumal Art & Water Community Park serves to provide a safe, fun environment for the children of Akumal pueblo located in the Riviera Maya area of Mexico.

Access to public beaches is challenging for the local Akumal families to attain. And it's a lengthy walk from the pueblo to the playa. This beautiful park, when completed, will be filled with fun water fountains, colorful murals, safe astroturf grass, gate/fencing, lighting, a stage, and benches.

The pueblo of Akumal receives virtually no financial support from the municipality of Tulum. For more than 3 decades, the expat population has been the primary financial supporter of Hekab Be Biblioteca which provides after-school and summer school learning for the pueblo children.



4 years ago, efforts were expanded to develop a street art festival to beautify and bring pride, and opportunities for commerce to the Akumal pueblo. The Akumal Arts Festival is now the largest street art festival in the world with nearly 500 murals in this tiny pueblo.

The Akumal Art & Water Community Park is now our latest effort to improve the lives of the children and their families.






Akumal Art & Water Community Park
